

CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

MAY 24, 2023

The Bagley City Council met on May 24, 2023, at 5:30 p.m. in the City Council Chambers.

Present: Mayor Sidney F. Michel, Councilmembers John Sutherland, Dennis Merschman, Jon Brovold and Chad Bonik, City Clerk Faye Jacobs and Deputy Clerk Priscilla Johnson.

Also Present: Bill Masterson and Allie Dalrymple.

Mayor Michel called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Mayor Michel requested the agenda be amended to include, under other business, an invoice from Bob Lowth and two invoices from VISA.

Brovold made a motion to accept the agenda with the amendments. Seconded by Sutherland, motion carried.

The Council discussed a recommendation from the Park & Recreation Board to purchase a golf cart from saferwholesale.com for \$7,800.00 to be used by the Park Attendant. It was the consensus of Council to do more research, possibly looking at the Toro brand golf carts.

Merschman made a motion to table the discussion on the park vehicle. Seconded by Bonik, motion carried.

Merschman made a motion to approve the payment of the VISA bill for the liquor store of \$916.74. Seconded by Brovold, motion carried.

Merschman made a motion approving Resolution #35-23 a variance request by Wade Crist. Seconded by Brovold, motion carried.

Bonik made a motion approving the Airport Maintenance and Operation Grant Application #1053247. Seconded by Sutherland, motion carried.

Bonik made a motion to approve Resolution #36-23 Authorization to Execute the Airport M & O. Seconded by Sutherland, motion carried.

Juneteenth is now a State Holiday. Motion was made by Bonik to add Juneteenth to the current Holidays observed by City Employees. Seconded by Sutherland, motion carried.

Mayor Michel was pleased to announce that the Bonding Bill passed, and the City has been awarded the funds they were seeking. He thanked several people that helped make it happen. There will be more details to come.

Brovold made a motion to approve Bob Lowth Ford to make repairs to the 2013 Ford Taurus Squad car of \$1,332.09. Seconded by Merschman, motion carried.

Brovold made a motion to approve payment of \$177.16 to VISA for a late received invoice. Seconded by Merschman, motion carried.

Being there was no further business to come before the board; motion to adjourn was made by Merschman. Seconded by Bonik, motion carried.
