Wild Rice Watershed District Project and Ditches Ownership

The Wild Rice Watershed District would like to remind residents that most of our projects and ditches remain under private landowner ownership. In most instances, the Wild Rice Watershed District does not own the property adjacent to the projects and ditches; rather it has purchased maintenance easements from property owners. This easement gives the District, its employees and consultants, the right to access the property for maintenance related issues. The Watershed easement along the project does not give authority to the general public to access the property for any reason.

Each year the Wild Rice Watershed District receives several calls regarding individuals entering private property along our projects and ditches. The Wild Rice Watershed District advises parties interested in accessing these areas to obtain permission from individual landowners along projects and ditches. Many of the counties within the District have a GIS Mapping link located on their website that can assist you with determining property owners.


