#### BAGLEY CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS April 15, 2025

report for the Municipal Liquor Store was also reviewed.

Liquor Store Manager Arnold presented the profit and loss statements for the past 5 years. He asked for permission to attend the annual NABCA conference in May and all costs are covered by the National Association. A motion was made by Bonik, seconded by Sutherland for Arnold to attend the NABCA conference. Arnold and Netland are attending the MMBA conference at the end of next week.

Fire Chief Netland let the council know Todd Brustad is retiring after 23 years of service. The generator got hooked up correctly to the lights at the fire hall. Netland requested for money to build a memorial cabinet from the insurance funds still remaining. Motion to build the cabinet made by Sutherland, seconded by Netland are attending the MMBA conference at the end of next week.

Police Chief Gunderson presented the monthly stats for calls from the police department. The body camera audit found a need to fulfill requirements for public comment period.

Motion made by Kaiser and seconded by Bonik to accept written public comment regarding body camera usage for the next two weeks, motion carried.

Minnesota Women of Police Association asked to use Gunderson's Use of Force Simulator the first week in May. Motion to approve Gunderson attending the conference with his training simulator made by Sutherland, seconded by Netland are attending the MMBA conference at the end of next week.

Updated animal ordinances are to be worked on and get passed as soon as possible.

Bemidji Area Regional Animal Control partnership was tabled until the next meeting.

Sutherland made a motion to approve the minutes of City Council meetings on March 12 and 26<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Seconded by Bonik, motion carried.

2. **YOU MUST

TO PROTECT YOUR  
RIGHTS OR IF SERVED  
BY PUBLICATION, 21  
DAYS AFTER FIRST  
PUBLICATION.** You must give or mail to the person who signed this Summons a written response called an Answer within 21 days of the date on which you received this Summons or within 21 days after the first publication of this Summons. You must send a copy of your Answer to the person who signed this Summons located at:

3. **YOU MUST  
RESPOND TO EACH  
CLAIM.** The Answer is your written response to the Plaintiff's Complaint. In your Answer, you must state whether you agree or

disagree with each paragraph of the Complaint. If you believe the Plaintiff should not be given everything asked for in the Complaint, you must say so in your Answer.

4. **YOU WILL LOSE  
YOUR CASE IF YOU DO  
NOT SEND A WRITTEN  
RESPONSE TO THE  
COMPLAINT TO THE  
PERSON WHO SIGNED  
THIS SUMMONS.** If you do not answer within 21 days, you will lose this case. You will not get to tell your side of the story, and the Court may decide against you and award the Plaintiff everything asked for in the Complaint. If you do not want to contest the claims stated in the Complaint, you do not need to respond. A default judgment can then be entered against you for the relief requested in the Complaint.

5. **L E G A L  
ASSISTANCE.** You may wish to get legal help from a lawyer. If you do not have a lawyer, the Court Administrator may have information about places where you can get legal assistance. Even if you cannot get legal help, you must still provide a written Answer to protect your rights or you may lose the case.

6. **ALTERNATIVE  
DISPUTE  
RESOLUTION.** The parties may agree to or be ordered to participate in an alternative dispute resolution process under Rule 114 of the Minnesota General Rules of Practice. You must still send your written response to the Complaint, even if you expect to use alternative means of resolving this dispute.
