CLEARWATER COUNTY PROPERTY TAX NOTICE FIRST HALF TAXES DUE MAY 15, 2026

Real Estate Taxes on the 1st half are due on or before May 15, 2026. On May 16, 2026, penalty of 2% will apply to homestead property and a penalty of 4% will apply to nonhomestead property. On June 1, 2026, the penalty will increase to 4% on homestead property and 8% on non-homestead property. These penalties will increase at the rate of 1% per month until October 1st when the penalty on homestead property becomes 8% and nonhomestead property becomes 12% on the unpaid first half. Personal Property Tax is due in full on May 15, 2026. Penalty of 8% applies on May 16, 2026, on any unpaid balance of the tax due. Please check your tax statement to see if your personal property taxes are due in full, or if only half of the taxes are due May 15th
