Board of Commissioners' June 9, 2026

The June 9, 2026, meeting for the Clearwater County Board of Commissioners commenced at 9:00 a.m. with Chairman Titera presiding and Commissioners Larson, Dukek, Emmel and Ramsrud present. The Board recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Agenda- Motion by Commissioner Emmel, seconded by Commissioner Larson and carried, to approve the agenda.

Minutes- Motion by Commissioner Dukek, seconded by Commissioner Ramsrud and carried, to approve May 19, 2026, Board Minutes.

Engineer - Motion by Commissioner Dukek, seconded by Commissioner Ramsrud and carried, to approve payment of the Clearwater County Highway Department bills as presented.

Motion by Commissioner Ramsrud, seconded by Commissioner Dukek, and carried, to award Engineering Services Contract for SAP 015-635-010 to Apex Engineering Group from Detroit Lakes, Minnesota in the amount of \$84,610.55.

Motion by Commissioner Ramsrud, seconded by Commissioner Emmel and carried, to hire Mr. Charlie Kaiser to the Part-time Seasonal position at the salary of Range 8, Step 1 of the non-union scale.

Recorder - Motion by Commissioner Larson, seconded by Commissioner Emmel and carried, to purchase TriMin's Land notification software for Recorder's Office, with initial installation and training cost of \$11,000.00; annual maintenance cost of \$1,500.00. Implementation and annual maintenance costs will be funded from the Recorder's Process Compliance Account.

Attorney - Motion by Commissioner Dukek, seconded by Commissioner Larson and carried, to amend the definition of PROPER IMMUNIZATION in the Clearwater County Animal Regulation Ordinance to the following: Proper immunization. For purposes of this Ordinance, "proper immunizations" means rabies inoculation by a licensed Veterinarian.

Sheriff - Motion by Commissioner Emmel, seconded by Commissioner Ramsrud and carried, to authorize the purchase of acoustic foam for the rec room in the jail and adhesive for the installation at a cost of \$8,448.68 from Grainger. Titera and carried, to authorize the County Auditor to pay the submitted invoices of \$185,973.84 from the County Revenue Fund and \$48,096.05 from the Public Health Fund.

By general consent, the Board waived the 3-day notice requirement for the following two motions.
